NO TAP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. USBC rules will apply. This tournament does not require USBC sanction.
2. Open to males and females. Youth bowlers may bowl, but all prize money will be converted to a scholarship through the USBC S.M.A.R.T. Program. Youth bowlers must fill out and sign the USBC waiver form and have it signed by their parent/ legal guardian. Any youth bowler who fails to notify tournament officials of his/her youth status will be disqualified, forfeit all prize money, and be reported to the USBC.
3. Highest final league average of 21 games or more from 2008-2009 will be used. If no average from 2008-2009, then 2007-2008 highest final average of 21 games or more will be used. Averages will be verified on Bowl.com. If no average exists, then current 2009-2010 average of 21 games or more will be used (bring in current league standing sheet for verification). All other bowlers will bowl scratch. If you are currently 10+ pins over previous year's average, you must notify us or you will be disqualified. Averages will be verified prior to payout.
4. Youth bowlers will use current league average of 21 games or more. Youth bowlers with no current average for the 2009-2010 of 21 games or more will bowl scratch.
5. All decisions made by the tournament officials are final. The tournament officials reserve the right to re-rate bowlers' averages or refuse entries if necessary.
6. Tournament officials reserve the right to disqualify a bowler after he/she has bowled the tournament if evidence is presented that proves falsification of entry, averages, scores, or unsportsmanlike conduct.
7. **HANDICAP** – 90% of 210.
8. Bowl as many times as you like, but cash only once.
9. **PRIZE FUND** – Tournament will payout 1 out of every 10 entries for handicap and one place for scratch. Advertised prize list is only an estimate based on 200 paid entries. Actual payout may differ due to actual number of paid entries and re-entries. One prize list for all bowlers. Payout will be made by May 31, 2010.
10. **NO TAP** – Bowl 3 games. All 1 pin leaves on first ball count as a strike. All other leaves count as usual. Pick up spares.
11. All protests must be made within 48 hours.
12. **ENTRY FEE** – \$25 first time entry. \$20 re-entry (must bring proof of prior entry to receive re-entry rate).
13. **Score changes must be made by Stardust Bowl II personnel. Any entry with unauthorized score changes will be disqualified.**
14. Two or more bowlers may bowl anytime lanes are available. Latest start time to bowl is 10 P.M. Tournament officials will decide how many people to put on a pair. You may make reservations for squads of 10 or more. Lanes will not be specially oiled for this tournament; you will bowl on the lanes as is.
